

How to use Parental Controls

Take control of your children's viewing experience with Parental Controls on Cobalt TV. Restrict channels, set restricted viewing times by time of day and day of week, and set programming limits based on motion picture ratings or TV ratings. If there is an attempt to tune to a channel with parental controls, a PIN must be entered. You can also restrict display of program titles at or above the rating limit in the guide.

To set up or change Parental Controls:

- •Select the "Menu" button on the remote. Select "Settings".
- •Select "Parental" and press the "OK" button.
- •Select the setting you would like to change.
- To change the PIN, select "Change PIN". Enter your new PIN and confirm it. Until you change it, the default PIN is 0000.





WatchTVEverywhere Your favorite programs, anytime, anywhere.

WatchTVEverywhere (WTVE) is easy to use and it's FREE* to all Cobalt TV subscribers.

WTVE streams many of your Cobalt TV subscribed channels and programming to your tablet, smartphone, laptop and other devices from anywhere you can receive an internet signal.

WTVE includes live sports coverage, as well as your other favorite programs. You can also watch full episodes of current TV shows within days of their premiere and catch up on the entire season or previous seasons of your favorite shows.

It's easy to start using WTVE. The first step is to register:

- •Visit CobaltTV.com and click on the WTVE banner.
- •Select Cobalt TV from the drop down menu.

- •Click on "Register". You will need your Cobalt TV account number which can be found on your monthly invoice.
- •Complete the registration form. The verification code is listed to the right of the entry box.
- •Once completed, you will receive an email with your WTVE activation link. Click on the link to complete the registration process.

This will provide you with login credentials that can be used on any of the streaming apps.

Make Your Home's Wi-Fi Faster

Tamilton offers fast internet speeds, but if your Wi-Fi Louter is more than a few years old or not set up correctly, it could be slowing you down. Here are some suggestions to help you maximize router performance and enjoy all of the internet speed you should be getting.

Move your router to a better location

For the strongest possible Wi-Fi connection, place your Wi-Fi router in the center of your home on a flat surface off the floor. It is best to place it somewhere up high and out in the open and away from thick, brick, stone, metal or concrete walls for maximum coverage. If you're in a multi-floor home or office, place your router on the top floor. Avoid interference from other devices by placing your router at least 10 feet away from devices like refrigerators, baby monitors, microwaves, cordless phones, garage door openers, halogen lamps and mirrors.

Upgrade your router

If your household has several people, each with a computer, phone, and tablet, plus a gaming console it will likely exceed the capacity of an entry-level router. A home network with this much online activity warrants the purchase of a new router that can handle more traffic and will maximize your current Wi-Fi signal.

Make sure your router is secure

Putting a password on your router or limiting which devices can access your network will keep other people from using your network and slowing it down.
