The eagle was found near Hampton and transported to Fontenelle Forest Raptor Recovery Center in Elmwood, Nebraska where it was treated for lead poisoning. Once healthy, the eagle was returned to Aurora for release, in collaboration with the Edgerton Explorit Center.



Birds of prey, such as eagles, falcons, hawks, owls and vultures have a vital role in our ecosystem. Fontenelle Forest's Raptor Recovery is focused on the conservation of these birds through education, research, and the rehabilitation of injured and orphaned raptors.
